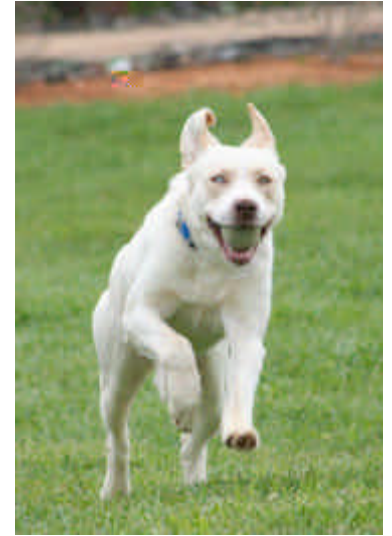

## ***A no-kill sanctuary means a second chance***

Over 8,000 unwanted animals are brought to the Rowan County Shelter each year. Many of these animals would surely find homes if they were just given a little more time and care. Faithful Friends can offer them this life-saving chance.



## ***Building the sanctuary***

Faithful Friends has obtained 10.6 acres by donation and by purchase for the site. Architect Jon Palmer's building plans will house 50 cats and 34 to 50 dogs, depending on their size. So far, over 100 volunteers from the community have offered to help build the sanctuary in a Habitat-for-Humanity-style construction.

### Building features:

- Isolation quarters for new arrivals with separate ventilation system
- Indoor/outdoor dog runs
- Communal cat room
- Screened cat sun porch
- Grooming room
- Adoption rooms
- Multipurpose room with retail sales



There will be a fenced park for our dogs, and a covered area where they can play in bad weather. A public dog park with membership fees is also planned. Walking trails are already present throughout the site. There will be a pet cemetery on the premises, with a memorial garden for other people's pets. We envision a wooden gazebo with benches in the middle of the garden area, surrounded by pet memorial stones and wind chimes.

## *Going green*

We will strive to make our sanctuary environmental-friendly. W. A. Brown & Son is working with us to provide the exterior walls of the sanctuary. These Siptex panels are considered “green” building materials with a R30 insulation rating (wabrown.com). The disinfecting system that we are interested in uses ozonated water, so no chemicals or protective equipment are needed. (ecosafesystemsusa.com)

Architect Jon Palmer’s design uses natural light and functioning windows to save on utilities and improve ventilation. It has a pitched roof to harvest rain water for irrigation of the dog parks and memorial garden. For energy efficiency, we plan to use solar panels for the water heater, light sensors in the rooms, and Energy Star light bulbs.



Palmer worked with surveyor Mel Thompson to position the building so that the cats get morning sun, and the dogs get winter sun and summer shade.



**An off-leash dog park is planned for the public.  
A membership fee and proof of vaccinations will be required.**
